Since 2014, Silicon Valley nonprofit agencies such as The Salvation Army have received close to **1 million meals** from HAH through Team San Jose and Levi's Stadium. The Salvation Army has served the delicious, high quality meals to hundreds of hungry men, women and children coming to receive free lunch and dinner at the Emanuel House Community Meals Program, as well as the Senior Nutrition Lunch Program. Such a great quantity of meals have been received that, more than once, the Emanuel House did not have to purchase food for the program and was able to use money saved to provide other direct services to people in great need.

Through Hunger at Home donor partners (The Fairmont, Marriott San Jose, Hilton and Doubletree Hotels), The Salvation Army now has new tables for their senior dining room. Other gently used, much needed items, such as bedding, dinnerware, and toiletries, have been provided to local non-profits by these generous donor partners. Hunger at Home, through generous donor partners, made it possible for The Salvation Army to conduct an elegant 2015 fundraising event at the San Jose McEnery Convention Center. The event was a great success because of that generosity. The monies raised have been used to provide care and resources for people in great need.
