Raffle Rules

1. Eligibility

Bridge the Gap Gala - Drive Thru Edition benefiting Hunger at Home (the "Raffle") is open to legal residents of the fifty (50) United States and the District of Columbia who are at least eighteen (18) years old at the time of entry. The Raffle is subject to federal, state, and local laws and regulations.

2. Sponsor

The Raffle is sponsored by Hunger at Home, located at 1560 Berger Drive, San Jose, California 95112.

3. Agreement to Official Rules

Participation in the Raffle constitutes entrant's full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these Official Rules and the decisions of the Sponsor, which are final and binding. Winning a prize is contingent upon being compliant with these Official Rules and fulfilling all other requirements set forth herein.

4. Raffle Period

The Raffle begins on October 24, 2020 at 2:00 PM Pacific and ends on October 24, 2020 at 5:00 PM Pacific (the "Raffle Period").

5. How to Enter

On-Site: Raffle Tickets may be purchased in person, on site during the Hunger at Home Bridge the Gap Gala.

Over the Phone: Tickets may be purchased by calling the raffle hotline during the raffle period.

Tickets will be sold for \$25 each, 5 tickets for \$100, 20 tickets for \$250, and 50 tickets for \$500

6. Prize Drawing

On or about October 24, 2020 at 5:30PM the Sponsor will select potential winners in a random drawing from among all eligible entries received - the drawing will be broadcast on Facebook Live - on the Hunger at Home Facebook page. The odds of being selected depend on the number of entries received. The Sponsor will post the winning number on the website and will include the winning number in an email to Gala attendees for which the organization has an email address. If the potential winner does not claim the prize within seven (7) days after the date of the first drawing, Sponsor may select an alternate potential winner in his/her place at random from the remaining non-winning, eligible entries. Each potential Grand and First Prize winner (parent/legal guardian if a minor in his/her state of residence) will be required to complete, electronically sign and submit a Declaration of Compliance within five (5) days of the date notice or attempted notice is sent, in order to claim his/her prize. If a potential winner cannot be contacted, or fails to submit the Declaration of Compliance within the required time period (if applicable), or prize is returned as undeliverable, potential winner forfeits prize. If the potential winner is at least 18 but still considered a minor in his/her jurisdiction of residence, Sponsor reserves the right to award the prize in the name of his/her parent or legal guardian, who will be required to sign the Declaration of Compliance on the potential winners behalf and fulfill any other requirements imposed on winner set forth herein. Potential winners must continue to comply with all terms and conditions of these Official Rules, and winning is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements. In the event that a potential winner is disqualified for any reason, Sponsor will award the applicable prize to an alternate winner by random drawing from among all remaining eligible entries. Only three (3) alternate drawings will be held, after which the prize will remain un-awarded. Prizes will be fulfilled in a timely manner after the conclusion of the raffle and may require the winner(s) to pick up the prize at 1560 Berger Drive, San Jose 95112
