## Youth Council vs School Clubs

The organization Hunger at Home (HH) oversees the Hunger at Home Youth Council (HHYC). The Youth Council, in turn, oversees Hunger at Home School Clubs (HHSC) that members may launch at their respective schools.

This means that all Hunger at Home School Club members are Youth Council members, but not vice versa.

All members may participate in Youth Council Events.

#### Hunger at Home Code of Conduct

of the Youth Council of Hunger at Home and Its School Clubs

Item 1

- All conduct of Youth Council and school club members shall accord with the mission of the Youth Council and of Hunger at Home.
- The instructions enclosed herein shall apply to all members of the Youth Council and school clubs, regardless of position, seniority, or any other factor not listed.

#### Item 2

- All affairs of the Youth Council and school clubs, internal and external, shall be conducted with a sense of community respect and environmental stewardship.
- Respectful actions ought to stem from genuine altruism, and not be done for the sake of
  compliance with these regulations or any other. That withstanding, this code and its
  delineations apply irrespective of an actor's specified intent.

#### Item 3

- All communication shall be kept professional, respectful, and constructive. This applies to matters both internal and external.
- Derogatory discrimination and bigotry are strictly forbidden and grounds for expulsion from the Youth Council and school clubs.
- A consistently high level of effort shall be maintained throughout the school year and brought to all attended Youth Council and school club meetings, activities, and functions.
- All school pertinent school guidelines shall be followed and upheld.

The Code of Conduct functions to set the expectations of the Hunger at Home Youth Council to ensure a positive, productive, and perceptive community.

This Code shall be implemented by ensuring it has been read and applying consequences as appropriate.

## 📑 Bylaws

### Youth Council

The Youth Council Bylaws describe the structure of the Youth Council, including the roles of the officers and how meetings and events shall be conducted.

This shall be read and agreed upon by prospective members.

#### **School Club**

The Club Bylaws establish the course of action a Youth Council Member would need to take to boot a Hunger at Home club at their school, and offer a structural guide on how the club shall be regulated.

This shall be read and agreed upon by those creating a club.

## Onboarding

#### **Youth Council**

The Youth Council Onboarding packet functions to introduce prospective members to the Hunger at Home Youth Council.

This may be used as fliers or invitations.

#### **School Club**

Similarly, the Club Onboarding packet is designed to welcome members to begin a Hunger at Home Club.

This may also be used as a flier or invitation.

## Application Forms

#### **Youth Council**

The Youth Council Application asks for general information, contact information, short answer question responses, and ensures that the user has read through the Youth Council's core documents.

This is to keep track and update active and new members.

#### **School Club**

All Club members are to concurrently file a Youth Council Application. School Club Applications function to inform the Youth Council that a member intends to begin a club at their school.

This form also includes short answer questions and requests contact information.
