#### New Little Saigon and Earthquakes PayPal Stadium Distribution Sites

Over the past year, we've expanded our distribution from one site to five sites. Our two newest locations in San Jose include Little Saigon and the Earthquakes PayPal Stadium. These sites make it possible for us to distribute food in accessible locations where our community needs it most.

#### FOOD DISTRIBUTION IMPACT OVER THE LAST YEAR WE

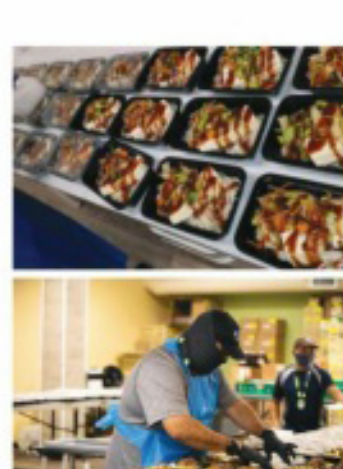
- 1 DISTRIBUTED 4M MEALS

#### HOW WE GREW FROM A SMALL NONPROFIT TO A FULL-SERVICE FOOD DISTRIBUTION OPERATION

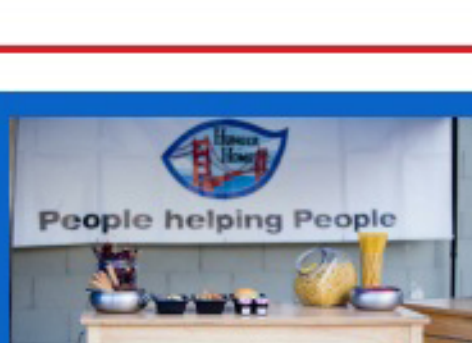
